RE: Annual Update to Nebraska Legislature

Senators of the Nebraska Legislature,

On behalf of the Board of Directors of the Southeast Nebraska Land Bank (Land Bank), I am sending this letter in compliance with the reporting requirements of the Nebraska Revised Statute §18-3413(3).

The Southeast Nebraska Land Bank was formed on August 7, 2023 between Falls City and Verdon and has implemented a successful strategy acquiring properties abandoned by the private market located between the downtown district and four of our five school buildings.

The Land Bank currently owns eight (8) properties. We recently sold our first property to the City of Falls City to build a 4-bedroom house with 1,662 sq. ft. of living space at 1223 Fulton utilizing the Rural Workforce Housing Funds. The Land Bank is assisting the Housing Board and City of Falls City to secure in-fill lots and bring them back to a revenue-producing position.

The Land Bank has accepted a \$60,000 loan at 0% interest for 10 years from Falls City EDGE to continue with strategic acquisitions of properties in our target zone. Our mission is to revive the core interior neighborhoods of Falls City while maintaining the charm of single-family home housing stock. With the recent announcement of Citroniq's \$5 billion project, acquisition for potential developers has become a priority. Citroniq wishes to be operational by Q1 of 2029.

In the last year, we made three (3) purchases exceeding \$2,500: 1604 Morton for \$7,583.95, 1612 Fulton for \$6,074.40, and 212 W. 10th for \$7,282.96. 1612 Fulton was sold and other properties acquired by donation or foreclosure are: 820 McLean, 1704 Morton, 710 W 21st, 1515 Lane, 813 Harlan, and 1223 Lane. All properties within a commercial or flex zone have been abandoned for at least three (3) years.

We do not have any paid staff, none have received payments exceeding \$2,500, and employees and Board members comply with the conflict-of-interest requirements as outlined in Nebraska Revised Statutes §18-3407 and §18-3415.

The Land Bank believes the information contained in this report to be complete and accurate. This report was submitted prior to the completion of a Land Bank annual audit.

A regular meeting of the Board Members of Southeast Nebraska Land Bank of the City of Falls City, Nebraska, was held at the City Hall, 2307 Barada Street in said City on the 13th day of February 2025, at 12:04 o'clock P.M. Present were: Board Members: Garrett Harring, Ed Harris, LaMarr Matthes, Rachel Rankin, Clint Sailors. Absent: Marilyn Capps, Toni Wintz. Also present was Director/Secretary, Lucas Froeschl; City Administrator, Anthony Nussbaum; Ex-Officio Mitch Merz; City Building Inspector, Blake Buckminster; and guest Joleen Stoller. Lucas Froeschl recorded the minutes of the meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Lucas Froeschl, Executive Director, gave the Director's Report. The Delinquent Tax Sale is scheduled for the First Monday of March (3/3/35) and discussed the Land Bank's strategy to identify properties the private market has abandoned. It was also noted that the 212 W 10^{th} Street property has been acquired by the Land Bank.

CONSENT AGENDA

A motion was made by Ed Harris and seconded by Clint Sailors to approve the consent agenda as follows: WHEREAS, certain business of the Southeast Nebraska Land Bank of the City of Falls City (City) transpires on a regular and routine basis or is not of controversial nature; and WHEREAS, roll call votes on each individual issue greatly extend the meeting time. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY the Southeast Nebraska Land Bank that in the interest of economizing time, yet complying with the Public Meeting Laws of the State of Nebraska, which require roll call voting, the following issues are hereby consolidated in this Consent Resolution: 1. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY the Southeast Nebraska Land Bank that the minutes from the January 9, 2025, regular meeting is hereby approved. 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY the Southeast Nebraska Land Bank that the agenda for February 13, 2025, is hereby approved. 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY the Southeast Nebraska Land Bank that the Treasurer's Report was given with \$69,434.90 in funds, of which \$30,000 is held in a CD. 4. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY the Southeast Nebraska Land Bank that the Consent Agenda for February 13, 2025, is hereby approved. Roll was called on this motion and the members voted as follows: "YEA" Garrett Harring, Ed Harris, LaMarr Matthes, Rachel Rankin, Clint Sailors. "NAY" None. Absent: Marilyn Capps, Toni Wintz. Motion carried.

LOT DEVELOPMENT: NIC SIELER, HILLCREST HOMES

A discussion was held after a presentation by Nic Sieler of Hillcrest Homes. He has offered options for a few pre-constructed homes that could fit on Land Bank lots, especially those that are 50-foot wide. Current city setbacks for residential side yards are 10 feet for primary residences, but Nic was noted many rural communities offer developer-friendly side setbacks at 5-1/2 to 7-1/2 feet as a standard variance. It was noted that this ordinance could be changed, but there is no immediate need to do so. The board believes there are enough 75-foot wide lots that we don't need to try and cram narrow houses on 50-foot wide lots. All of the homes Nic offers meet the 2019 IRC-codes for homes; they are not HUD-coded homes. Nic offered suggestions for what other communities are doing to solve housing issues and noted his willingness to assist Falls City. He invited the board to visit the factory in York, Nebraska. Discussion item only, no motion was made.

REDEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT

A discussion was held regarding a Redevelopment Agreement for buyers of Land Bank properties. The goal is to ensure Land Bank properties are developed once acquired. The Redevelopment Agreement proposes 8 months to return an existing property to a habitable condition or 12 months in the case of a vacant lot or commercial/industrial building. The board suggested adding a penalty clause that the Land Bank is compensated for each lost year based on assessed value and what could have been collected via the 50% division of taxes statute. A motion was made by Clint Sailors and seconded by Rachel Rankin to approve the agreement along with penalty clause. Roll was called on this motion and the members voted as follows: "YEA" Garrett Harring, Ed Harris, LaMarr Matthes, Rachel Rankin, Clint Sailors. "NAY" None. Absent: Marilyn Capps, Toni Wintz. Motion carried.

FOR SALE BY OWNER SIGNAGE

A discussion was held regarding for sale signage at properties owned by the Land Bank. The Nebraska Real Estate Commission Director was contacted who said this is allowable but suggested we use For Sale by Owner instead of just For Sale. Multiple options were presented with heavy duty angle iron signs, more affordable gauge wire frames (new and used), and the board ultimately decided to go with the more affordable gauge wire frames and local printer for full color double sided coroplast signs. It was noted to include For Sale By Owner text, land bank logo, phone number, and QR code to website with lot listings. A motion was made by Clint Sailors and seconded by Garrett Harring to approve the purchase of +/- 25 coroplast signs from Merz Ink to fit on affordable gauge wire frames estimated at under \$350. Roll was called on this motion and the members voted as follows: "YEA" Garrett Harring, Ed Harris, LaMarr Matthes, Rachel Rankin, Clint Sailors. "NAY" None. Absent: Marilyn Capps, Toni Wintz. Motion carried.

Board Member Ed Harris had to excuse himself for another obligation and excited the meeting.

2025 LAWN MOWING BIDS

A discussion was held regarding lawn mowing bids for the 2025 season. It was noted that the previous year's contract can be extended with existing vendor if holding previous bid price. 2024 bid price was \$25.46 per lot per montb. The Land Bank currently owns 23 lots at 8 locations: 820 McLean (2 lots), 1704 Morton (4 lots), 1604 Morton (4 lots), 710 W 21st (2 lots), 1515 Lane (2 lots), 813 Harlan (3 lots), 1223 Lane (2 lots), 212 W 10th (4 lots.) A motion was made by Clint Sailors and seconded by Rachel Rankin to extend the 2024 agreement with Gerdes Lawn Care through the 2025 season at \$25.46 per lot per month. Roll was called on this motion and the members voted as follows: "YEA" Garrett Harring, LaMarr Matthes, Rachel Rankin, Clint Sailors. "NAY" None. Absent: Marilyn Capps, Ed Harris, Toni Wintz. Motion carried.

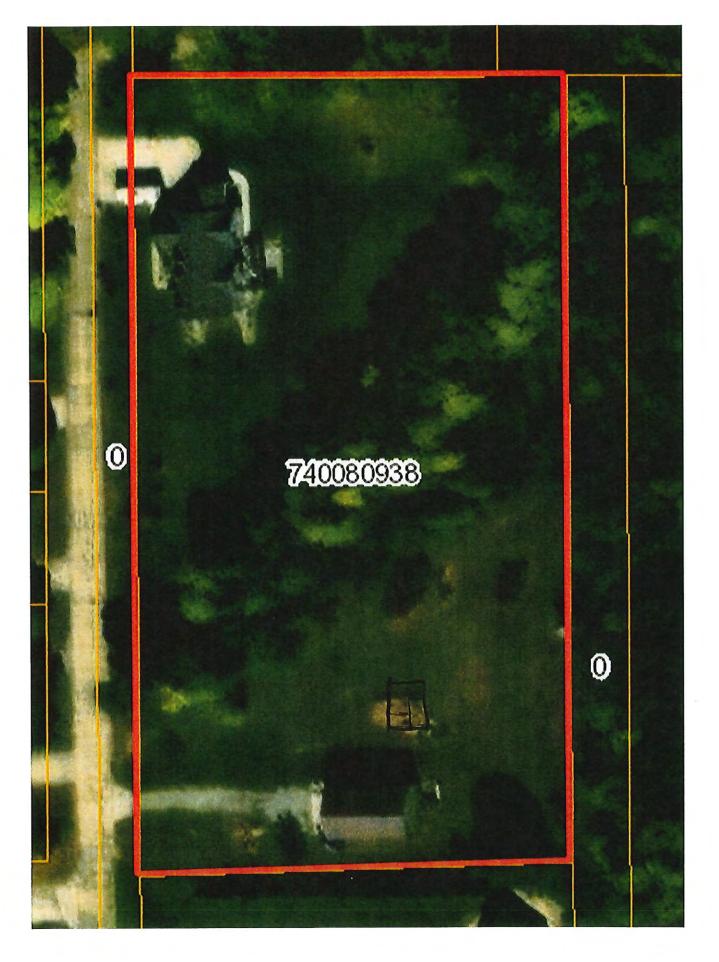

Sec. 7-3. - Wild or exotic animals.

- (a) Possession, sale prohibited. No person shall keep, or permit to be kept, any wild or exotic animal, as a pet, for display or for exhibition purposes, for profit or personal use, within the confines of the city limits. No person or commercial animal establishment shall offer any wild or exotic animal for sale.
- (b) Definition. "Wild or exotic animal" shall mean:

Any cat other than felis catus;

Non-human primates other than monkey;

Canine other than canis familiaris;

Poisonous reptile;

Alligator, crocodile or lizard over two (2) feet long;

Snake over six (6) feet long;

Any other live animal normally found living in a state of nature and not normally subjected to domestication, including, but not limited to: skunks, lions, bears, kangaroo, eagle, buffalo and/or beefalo;

Any poisonous stinging insect or arachnid.

- (c) Exemptions for animals owned prior to effective date of this section. Any person owning a wild or exotic animal at the time of enactment of this section, may pending approval of the chief of police and the city inspector, obtain a permit to retain said wild or exotic animal; provided that:
 - (1) A permit application is filed with the chief of police and the city inspector within forty-five (45) days of the effective date of this section;
 - (2) The facilities for housing and containment of said wild or exotic animal are inspected and found to be adequate to prevent such animal from escaping or injuring the public or public safety personnel acting in an official capacity;
 - (3) An annual permit fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) is paid by the owner to the city;
 - (4) Upon the death, sale, adoption, exchange, transfer or disposal of said wild or exotic animal, the animal may not be replaced.

Concession Operations at Fiedler Family Ball Complex and Morehead Field

This Agreement is made on <u>March 1st, 2025</u> between the City of Falls City, Nebraska (the Lessor) and <u>Girl Scout Troop 20566</u> (the Lessee).

The City of Falls City, Nebraska has leased the north and south concession stand buildings for the Fiedler Family Ball Complex at Dallas Jones Memorial Park in Falls City, Nebraska, to the Lessee effective from March 1st, 2025, to September 30, 2025. In addition, the City of Falls City, Nebraska provides the rights for the lessee to operate a portable concession stand for Morehead Field at Grandview Park.

The Lessee in consideration of the leasing of said property, hereby covenants and agrees to and with lessor to pay the lessor as rent for the same, as follow, per year, to-wit: (\$15.00) Fifteen Dollars and No Cents, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the Lessor.

 - c. Popcorn
 - d. Assortment of candy
 - e. Ice cream
- 4. The Lessee shall be responsible for any and all damage to the concession stand and its contents during the term of this lease.
- 5. Lessee shall not have the right to sublet or assign this lease.
- 6. Lessee shall be responsible for all costs of utilities.
- 7. Lessee shall be responsible for any costs and expenses to operate and maintain their business at the concessions stand. All expenses for obtaining licenses and permits to operate said business shall be obtained at the Lessees expense.

- 8. If the Lessee shall fail to perform any covenant, agreements, or obligations hereunder, this lease may be forfeited and hereby become null and void at the option of the Lessor and the Lessor may immediately, or at any time hereafter, reenter the premises, repossess the same, and remove therefrom all goods and chattels of Lessee and dispossess the Lessee and anyone claiming by or under him.
- 9. This covenant and agreement shall continue to and be binding upon heirs, executors, administrators and the parties to this lease.

Dear Anthony:

JK Energy Consulting, LLC (JKEC) is pleased to submit this letter agreement to prepare a Cost of Service and Rate Design Study for the City of Falls City (City) and its electric, natural gas, water, and wastewater utilities (Utilities). This letter agreement is in reply to our discussion in late December and includes the scope of services, relevant experience, fee proposal, and proposed schedule.

JKEC is a Nebraska limited liability corporation formed in 2009 by John A. Krajewski. Mr. Krajewski is a professional engineer licensed to practice in the State of Nebraska. The mission of JKEC is to provide *independent*, *objective* advice to consumers and producers of energy. Since 2009, JKEC has served more than 105 clients in eight states.

Familiarity with Falls City

Through his utility and consulting background, Mr. Krajewski is familiar with the rates charged by the electric utility's wholesale power suppliers. JKEC has prepared cost of service studies for the City's four utilities (electric, natural gas, water, and wastewater) five times over the last 15 years. In 2011, JKEC evaluated the City's existing power supply arrangements. Mr. Krajewski has also prepared the Integrated Resource Plan for Falls City on five different occasions, most recently in 2022.

Proposed Scope of Services

The following tasks will be completed for each of the Utilities using methodologies and guidelines that are generally accepted within the industry for the particular utility. The proposed approach will be to collect data for all four Utilities at the initial data collection meeting.

Task 1: Data Collection. This task involves collecting retail usage, operating expense, purchased power, and other data necessary to complete the cost of service analysis. A data request will be prepared and submitted to the Utility. To the extent certain data is not available, alternatives to the requested data will be identified.

This task includes having an initial meeting with City staff to review the important issues for each of the Utilities. Based on previous experience with the City, some of the key issues for the various Utilities include:

Electric

- Ensuring adequate revenue to cover operating expenses and debt service
- Ensuring production cost adjustment factors are correct
- Paying debt service associated with new peaking generation and other capital improvements
- Ensuring cost recovery of new transmission interconnection

Natural Gas

- Ensuring the purchased gas adjustment consistent with wholesale gas costs
- Ensuring adequate revenue for distribution operations and maintenance costs
- Ensuring adequate revenue from transport-only customers, if applicable
- Paying for proposed capital improvement projects

Wat<u>er</u>

- Ensuring adequate revenue to cover operating expenses and debt service
- Ensuring appropriate seasonal rates to reflect peak day usage
- Paying for proposed capital improvement projects

Wastewater

- Ensuring adequate revenue to cover operating expenses and debt service
- Reviewing need for rates for industrial or process sewage, including high concentrations of total suspended solids (TSS) or higher biochemical oxidation demand (BOD)
- Paying for proposed capital improvement projects

Task 2: Identify Capital Requirements. This task involves reviewing the City's capital improvement program and identifying the cash flow requirements necessary to fund planned projects. Appropriate funding mechanisms will be evaluated, including funding from revenue, use of reserves, issuance of debt, or a combination of the above approaches.

Task 3: Calculate Revenue Requirements and Financial Results. This task involves reviewing the projected operating expenses, non-retail revenues, capital requirements from Task 2, debt service expenses and other elements that make up the projected revenue requirements. Revenue requirements will be calculated for a "Test Year" and for

a projected period of four additional years (a total of five years). Projected retail revenues will be compared to projected expenses to develop projected financial results going forward. The projected financial results are used to identify necessary rate increases for future periods. Debt service coverage will be calculated to determine compliance with bond covenants and cash reserves will be reviewed for adequacy. Projected cash reserves will be calculated and compared to operating expenses to assess if additional reserves are necessary.

Task 4: Prepare Cost of Service Analysis. This task involves calculating the cost of service for each retail rate class, using generally accepted ratemaking principles for municipal utilities. Principles consistent with guidelines prepared by the American Public Power Association, the National Association of Regulatory Utilities Commissioners, American Water Works Association, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, and others would be followed.

The various expenses incurred by the Utility will be identified and assigned to a function based on the type of service provided. For example, the electric cost of service will be allocated to generation, transmission, distribution, and customer service while the water cost of service will be allocated based on water consumption, peak day and peak hour usage. An appropriate method for allocating expenses for each function among the various rate classes will be identified. For example, purchased energy costs may be allocated based on the energy purchased by each retail class, while customer service expenses may be allocated based on the weighted number of retail customers. In general, the approach will be similar to the 2022 rate studies, unless the City would like alternative approaches evaluated.

The allocated cost of service for each rate class will be compared to the projected revenues for each rate class to determine the need for future rate changes and provide guidance for the rate design process.

Task 5: Rate Design. This task involves designing retail rates for each rate class. Rate design factors include the cost of service results as well as other goals established by the Utility. These goals may include long-term rate stability, competitiveness with neighboring utilities, financial stability, mitigation of large rate increases, and funding of future capital projects. A discussion of the relative merits of various rate design approaches will be developed, with the preferred approach identified. The overriding goal will be to design rates that meet the standard of being fair, reasonable, and non-discriminatory. JKEC will meet with Utility staff to review these goals and establish rates that best accomplish the identified goals.

A rate ordinance that includes rate changes for up to three years (annual changes in October 2025, October 2026, and October 2027) in the future will be developed in a manner consistent with recent rate studies. Rate comparisons with neighboring utilities will be prepared.

Task 6: Draft Report. This task involves preparing a draft report for review by Utility staff and the Board of Public Works (BPW). The report will be suitable for review by non-Utility personnel with tables that summarize the key results of the cost of service analysis. Updated rate ordinances will be provided that implements the proposed rates.

Task 7: Present Final Report. This task involves presenting the results to a joint meeting of the BPW and City Council. The report will be suitable for review by the City Council with tables that summarize the key results of the cost of service analysis. Updated rate ordinances will be provided that implement the proposed rates. JKEC staff will present the report and be available to answer any questions.

Deliverables for Each Utility

- 1. One electronic copy of each draft summary report (summary form of report with proposed rate ordinance) for staff review.
- 2. One electronic copy of each final summary report, including proposed rate ordinances, for a joint meeting of BPW / City Council.
- Presentation of results to the BPW and City Council at a regularly scheduled meeting.
- 4. One electronic copy of each final report, including all work papers, in Adobe Acrobat (.pdf) format.
- 5. One hard copy of each full final report, including all work papers, any changes resulting from BPW or City Council action, and implemented rate ordinances.
- 6. One electronic copy of each proposed rate ordinance in Microsoft Word format.

Fee Proposal

The lump sum fee, including billed time and out-of-pocket expenses, to provide the above-listed Scope of Services for each utility as follows, based on JKEC being retained to perform all studies for all four utilities. The total lump sum cost for all four studies is \$22,000.

Electric: \$7,000
Natural Gas: \$6,000
Water: \$4,500
Wastewater: \$4,500

Fees will be invoiced on the following schedule upon completion of the following milestones:

Upon completion of data request meeting: 10%
Completion of draft reports: 40%
Presentation to joint BPW/City Council Meeting: 40%
Provide final versions of rate studies: 10%

Invoices will be transmitted electronically via email and are due upon receipt. Interest accrues on unpaid balances after 15 days at a rate of 1% per month.

Schedule / Meetings

The following schedule is based on a notice to proceed on February 1, 2025, and four site visits. Any delay in issuing the notice to proceed or providing requested data will result in a similar delay in subsequent milestones. This schedule provides for approval of rates by the City Council in August 2025, with implementation consistent with the beginning of Fiscal Year 2026.

May 1: Draft reports complete and sent to Utility staff
May 15: Review draft reports with City and Utility staff

June 15: Present draft reports at a joint meeting of the BPW and

submitted to the City

October 1: Implementation of rate changes, if applicable

The proposed fee includes three site visits. If additional visits are requested, billing will be based on JKEC's standard billing rate schedule, which is attached to this proposal (see Attachment 1).

Utility Responsibility

The Utility will be responsible for:

- Providing requested data on a timely basis, including timely response to any questions or clarifications regarding the provided data.
- · Reviewing draft studies on a timely basis.
- Scheduling appropriate meeting(s) with the BPW, City Council, and others.

Additional Services

Any services not included in the Scope of Services will only be provided upon written agreement by the City and JKEC. Such services will be billed at JKEC's standard billing rate schedule, which is attached to this proposal (see Attachment 1).

NONDISCLOSURE AGREEMENT

	This Nondisclosure Agreement (this "Agreement") is made as of this day of

Corpora	ion("Recipient"). Company and Recipient may be referred to herein
individu	ally as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties".

WHEREAS, in connection with a possible transaction between Company and Recipient described as the development, construction, operation, and potential partnership or investment opportunities related to a new power generation facility, including but not limited to feasibility studies, resource planning, infrastructure requirements, and regulatory compliance (the "Purpose"), Recipient desires to review and evaluate certain information of Company that is non-public, confidential or proprietary in nature.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants, terms, and conditions set out herein, the Parties agree as follows:

- l. Confidential Information. Except as set out in Section 2 below, "Confidential Information" means all non-public, confidential, or proprietary information, including, but not limited to, any trade secrets disclosed before, on or after the Effective Date, disclosed by the Company or its affiliates to Recipient, its employees, or its agents, representatives, attorneys, accountants, or any other advisors (collectively, "Representatives"), whether disclosed orally or disclosed or accessed in written, electronic, or other form or media, and whether or not marked, designated, or otherwise identified as "confidential", and all notes, analyses, compilations, reports, data, statistics, summaries, interpretations, and other materials (the "Notes") prepared by or for Recipient or its Representatives that contain, are based on, or otherwise reflect or are derived from, in whole or in part, any of the foregoing.
- 2. **Exclusions from Confidential Information**. Except as required by applicable federal, state, or local law or regulation, the term "Confidential Information" as used in this Agreement shall not include information that:
 - (a) at the time of disclosure is, or thereafter becomes, generally available to and known by the public other than as a result of, directly or indirectly, any violation of this Agreement by Recipient or any of its Representatives;
 - (b) at the time of disclosure is, or thereafter becomes, available to Recipient on a non-confidential basis from a third-party source, provided that such third party is not and was not prohibited from disclosing such Confidential Information to Recipient by a legal, fiduciary, or contractual obligation to the Company; or
 - (c) was or is independently developed by Recipient, as established by documentary evidence, without reference to or use of, in whole or in part, any of the Company's Confidential Information.

3. Recipient's Obligations. Recipient shall:

(a) protect and safeguard the confidentiality of all such Confidential Information with at least the same degree of care as Recipient would protect its own Confidential Information, but in no event with less than a commercially reasonable degree of care;

- (b) not use the Company's Confidential Information, or permit it to be accessed or used, for any purpose other than the Purpose or any related transactions between the Parties, or otherwise in any manner to the Company's detriment;
- (c) not disclose any such Confidential Information to any person or entity, except to Recipient's Representatives who: (i) need to know the Confidential Information to assist Recipient, or act on its behalf, in relation to the Purpose or to exercise its rights under the Agreement; (ii) are informed by Recipient of the confidential nature of the Confidential Information; and (iii) are subject to confidentiality duties or obligations to Recipient that are no less restrictive than the terms and conditions of this Agreement; and
- (d) be responsible for any breach of this Agreement caused by any of its Representatives.
- 4. Additional Confidentiality Obligations. Except as required by applicable federal, state, or local law or regulation, or otherwise as agreed in writing by the Company, Recipient shall not disclose, nor permit any of its Representatives to disclose to any person: (a) that the Confidential Information has been made available to Recipient or its Representatives, or that it has inspected any portion of the Confidential Information; (b) that discussions or negotiations may be, or are, underway between the Parties regarding the Confidential Information or the Purpose, including the status thereof; or (c) any terms, conditions, or other arrangements that are being discussed or negotiated in relation to the Confidential Information or the Purpose.
- Required Disclosure. Any disclosure by Recipient or its Representatives of any of the Company's Confidential Information under applicable federal, state, or local law, regulation, or a valid order issued by a court or governmental agency of competent jurisdiction (a "Legal Order") shall be subject to the terms of this Section. Before making any such disclosure, Recipient shall provide the Company with: (a) prompt written notice of such requirement so that the Company may seek, at its sole cost and expense, a protective order or other remedy; and (b) reasonable assistance, at the Company's sole cost and expense, in opposing such disclosure or seeking a protective order or other limitations on disclosure. If, after providing such notice and assistance as required herein, Recipient remains subject to a Legal Order to disclose any Confidential Information, Recipient (or its Representatives or other persons to whom such Legal Order is directed) shall disclose no more than that portion of the Confidential Information which, on the advice of Recipient's legal counsel, such Legal Order specifically requires Recipient to disclose and, on the Company's request, shall use commercially reasonable efforts to obtain assurances from the applicable court or agency that such Confidential Information will be afforded confidential treatment.
- 6. Return or Destruction of Confidential Information. At any time during or after the term of this Agreement, at the Company's written request, Recipient and the Representatives shall promptly return to the Company all copies, whether in written, electronic, or other form or media, of the Company's Confidential Information, or destroy all such copies and certify in writing to the Company that such Confidential Information has been destroyed. In addition, Recipient shall also destroy all copies of any Notes created by Recipient or its Representatives and certify in writing to the Company that such copies have been destroyed.
- 7. **Term and Termination**. The term of this Agreement shall commence on the Effective Date and shall expire three (3) years from the Effective Date.
- 8. **No Representations or Warranties.** For purposes of this Agreement, neither the Company nor any of its Representatives make any representation or warranty, expressed or implied, as to the accuracy or completeness of the Confidential Information disclosed to Recipient hereunder. For

purposes of this Agreement, neither the Company nor any of its Representatives shall be liable to Recipient or any of its Representatives relating to or resulting from Recipient's use of any of the Confidential Information or any errors therein or omissions therefrom.

- 9. **No Transfer of Rights, Title, or Interest**. The Company retains its entire right, title, and interest, including all intellectual property rights, in and to all of its Confidential Information. Any disclosure of such Confidential Information hereunder shall not be construed as an assignment, grant, option, license, or other transfer of any such right, title, or interest whatsoever to Recipient or any of its Representatives.
- 10. **No Other Obligation**. The Parties agree that neither Party shall be under any legal obligation of any kind whatsoever, or otherwise be obligated to enter into any business or contractual relationship, investment, or transaction, by virtue of this Agreement, except for the matters specifically agreed to herein. Either Party may at any time, at its sole discretion with or without cause, terminate discussions and negotiations with the other Party, in connection with the Purpose or otherwise.
- 11. **Remedies**. Recipient acknowledges and agrees that money damages might not be a sufficient remedy for any breach or threatened breach of this Agreement by Recipient or its Representatives. Therefore, in addition to all other remedies available at law (which the Company does not waive by the exercise of any rights hereunder), the Company shall be entitled to seek specific performance and injunctive and other equitable relief as a remedy for any such breach or threatened breach, and Recipient hereby waive any requirement for the securing or posting of any bond or the showing of actual monetary damages in connection with such claim.

12. General.

- (a) Governing Law; Jurisdiction and Venue. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the internal laws of the State of Nebraska without giving effect to any choice or conflict of law provision or rule (whether of the State of Nebraska or any other jurisdiction) that would cause the application of laws of any jurisdiction other than those of the State of Nebraska. Any legal suit, action, or proceeding arising out of or related to this Agreement or the matters contemplated hereunder shall be instituted exclusively in the federal courts of the United States or the courts of the State of Nebraska in each case located in the County of Richardson, and each Party irrevocably submits to the exclusive jurisdiction of such courts in any such suit, action, or proceeding and waives any objection based on improper venue or forum non conveniens. Service of process, summons, notice, or other document by mail to such Party's address set out herein shall be effective service of process for any suit, action, or other proceeding brought in any such court.
