

Job Opening Police Officer

The Falls City Police Department is currently accepting applications for the position of Police Patrol Officer (Entry-Level or Certified). The Individual will perform police patrol, investigation, traffic regulation and city ordinance enforcement.

Requirements:

High school graduate or GED, at least 21 years of age, no serious misdemeanors or felony convictions. Testing will include the physical fitness test as required by NLETC, oral interview, psychological interview, and an extensive background check.

Officers That are Nebraska certified are offered a hiring incentive of \$10,000 and a wage starting at \$31.14/hr. (Negotiable dependent on years of experience after completion of NLETC requirements for certification)

Candidates that are certified in other states start at \$31.14. (Negotiable dependent on years of experience and after completion of NLETC requirements for certification for out of state certifications)

Applicants that are uncertified will start at \$24.94, wage will increase upon completion of becoming a certified officer. The applicant must enroll and successfully complete the course at Nebraska Law Enforcement Training Center, which will be provided by the City.
